MAYOR'S MESSAGE

It seems as though we were just shaking off the last snow and now, here we are ready to welcome summer. That is fine with me, I have never been so glad to see winter go as I have this year. Even spring took a long time to get started, but I am sure glad it has arrived. Enough on the weather, we have a lot to talk about in this issue of the Taneytown Record. We have mid-term elections coming up much earlier this year. Primary elections have been moved to the 24th of June. Early voting starts on June 12th (and runs thru June 19th), with the General election to be held on November 4th. Make sure you find time to select the folks who will shape our political future for the next several years. We will be voting Governor and Lt. Governor, for many local offices including county council member to represent the Taneytown and Manchester areas. Three delegates to represent most of Carroll Co. in Annapolis, a state Senator, a Sheriff and States Attorney. The County Board of Educations will also be held. We will be electing as well, a representative to the US Congress (House of Representatives) and various judges. No City elections will be held this year, next year though, May 2015 you will be voting for a Mayor and two Council members. Please take time to vote, your vote truly does count.

WATER/SEWER BILLS

Water/sewer bills will be issued July 1st with a due date of July 31st. Any bill not paid by 3pm on the 31st will be assessed a 10% late penalty and will be due by August 18th by 3pm. Water shut off will be scheduled after August 19th, 2014. If water service is interrupted for non-payment, there will be an additional fee of \$50 to reconnect water service.

WATER AND SEWER RATES INCREASE

Effective with the quarterly billing period beginning July 1, 2014, water and sewer rate will increase. The new rate will be reflected on the bill for the quarter ending September 30, 2014. Please keep in mind that if final reads are requested after July 1, 2014 the new rates will apply. The new water rate will be \$6.53 per 1,000 gallons and the sewer rate will be at \$12.81 per 1,000 gallons. The rate increase is based on the adopted resolution passed in 2011 to fund low interest rate loans secured to pay for needed public water and sewer improvement projects. PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

TRASH & RECYCLING:

- Week of Independence Day: Collection will take place on its normally scheduled day; Wednesday, July 2, 2014.
- Please be Reminded: The 64 gallon blue recycling containers the city had purchased are for recycling only. The containers are not to be used for trash, and shall not be altered in any way. The containers are the property of the City Taneytown, and must remain at the address at which they were placed indefinitely.

YARD WASTE REMINDER:

The Public Works Department provides weekly pick up of grass clippings on Tuesdays. Remember; you must call the City Office no later than 3 p.m. the Monday before the Tuesday you wish to have yard waste collected. Currently there are no charges to Carroll County residents for the disposal of yard waste, at the County Landfill in Westminster (410) 386-4550:

- Please place your bags at the curb by 7:30 a.m., the morning of pick up.
- Yard waste must be placed in paper-kraft bags only.
- Please limit the weight of bags so they can easily be lifted for loading and unloading without bag breakage.
- This service is limited to grass clippings, flower & shrubbery trimmings only. Please do not dispose of tree branches, dirt, sod, thistle, or household garbage.

GRASS CLIPPINGS:

Please do not sweep or blow grass and debris into the street. This practice can block downstream storm water inlet grates and pipes causing storm water to backup into the street, creating flooding

Last issue I spent some time talking with you about the struggle Council was having coming up with a budget that avoided any tax hikes. I am pleased to say that with a lot of hard work and a firm commitment to the citizens of Taneytown, your Mayor and Council with the help of our City staff have passed a budget that does not increase taxes. One thing not so pleasant, though, is that our water and sewer rates are scheduled to increase in July. This is due to a funding plan adopted by Council several years ago to address the mandatory improvements required by the State of Maryland to upgrade our waste water treatment plant. In other news that affects your pocketbook, we were successful in obtaining additional Highway User Revenues (HURs) that the legislature stripped from us early in the O'Malley/Brown administration. The ability of the state's municipalities, working together through Maryland Municipal League (MML) has once again paid big dividends. While the funds were not completely restored to historic levels, we have been given more this year than in any year since the O'Malley/Brown took office. Additionally, Police Revenues (also cut by the administration) have been restored.

In news around town, it was my pleasure to attend a local Cub Scout Pack 633 meeting in April. The occasion for my attendance was to recognize a truly "Hometown Hero". Lt. Col. Daniel

Collins, of the Maryland National Guard is retiring from his leadership role with Pack 633. Lt. Col. Collins is a gulf war veteran and a Bronze Star recipient. With all this to his credit he still found time to devote the last several years to guiding our young scouts. It is times like these that make me so proud to be a member of the Taneytown Community and to be your Mayor. I have



said many times that volunteer's like Lt. Col. Collins make this community what it is. When you see Dan around town be sure to thank him and wish him well. Summertime means outdoors. And your City has some great plans for the coming season. On Saturday, May the 23rd we hold our annual Fishing Derby, with super prizes and fun for all. I hope you had a chance to participate with your children or grandchildren. Coming up in June we'll have the Street Cars of Desire annual car show in Memorial Park. I will be awarding the Mayor's trophy for my favorite, Come on down, it's Free! The Fireman's Carnival is next, truly the best carnival for miles around, I may be prejudiced. TANEYTOWN HERITAGE COMMITTEE AND HISTORY MUSEUM SPRING MEETINGS

The Heritage Committee began their spring meeting schedule on March 24 with guest speaker Hilda Koontz, living historian, provided a vivid account of the Civil War and the story of the Fleagle family of Carroll County, of which four sons served in the Union. She read excerpts from actual letters of the Fleagle family members. Hilda became interested in the family history when she saw two of the Fleagle tombstones at Emmanuel Baust Church cemetery, Tyrone. She provided insight as to what life was like on the front lines and at home in the 1860's. Hilda has been a reenactor for more than 20 years and serves as vice president of the Civilians of Gettysburg reenactment group. She is a frequent speaker at the Civil War Roundtables and the National Museum of Civil War Medicine.

April 28 Dean L. Minnich, author of "Towns and Villages of Carroll County" spoke to the group. His focus was how each small town in the county is unique and all share common traits. Dean Minnich is a resident of Carroll County, former Carroll County Commis-

sioner, retired newspaper editor and manager, a writer for numerous news media and author of five books.

May 19 concluded the spring meeting series with local town residents Brenda (Clem) Clapsaddle and Linda (Clem) Warehime, daughters of Kenneth Clem providing photographic "Memories of Taneytown from the Clem collection". Kenneth, who was a professional photographer, moved to Taneytown in 1938 and took photos in the Taneytown area from the late 1930's to early 1960's. He was also the manager and projection operator at the Taneytown Movie Theater which is now the location of the New Asia Restaurant. Kenneth was also the manager of the Taneytown Drive-in at Bridgeport and family members assisted by selling tickets and helping at the snack bar. Photos shown from the collection included the former Taney Inn, 1942 Harney snow storm and John Welty, Sr. (about 10 years old) who was the winner of a bicycle at the Taneytown Movie Theater.

The fall meeting schedule begins September, October and November with a holiday dinner. All meetings are held at Trinity Lutheran Church, 38 W. Baltimore Street, Fellowship Hall. Light refreshments are served. The public is invited to attend.

on Fort McHenry during the War of 1812. The fort withstood the day-long assault, inspiring Key to write a poem that would become the future U.S. national anthem, "The Star-Spangled Banner." Key later served as a District Attorney for Washington, D.C. He died on January 11, 1843.

By the early 1810s, the United States had entered into conflict with Britain over the kidnapping of U.S. seamen and the disruption of trade with France. The ensuing hostilities would come to be known as the War of 1812.

On Sept. 14, 1814, Francis Scott Key peered through clearing smoke to see an enormous flag flying proudly after a 25-hour British bombardment of Baltimore's Fort McHenry. After continual bombing, to Key's surprise, the

British were not able to destroy the Fort, and Key noted upon the dawning of the next morning a large U.S. flag being flown. (It had in fact been sewn by Mary Young Pickersgill at the request of the Fort commander.)

The British ceased their attack and left the area. Key immediately wrote down the words for a poem that he would continue composing at an inn the next day. The work, which relied heavily on visualizations of what he witnessed, would come to be known as the "Defence of Fort M'Henry" and was printed in handbills and newspapers, including the Baltimore Patriot. The poem was later set to the tune of a drinking song by John Stafford Smith, "To Anacreon in Heaven," and came to be called "The Star-Spangled Banner."

"The Star-Spangled Banner" continued to be held up as a U.S. musical symbol although facing criticism: the song being labeled by some as violent and boasting unwieldy lyrics. Decades later, in 1916, President Woodrow Wilson declared "The Star-Spangled Banner" should be played at official events. On March 3, 1931, President Herbert Hoover along with Congress had the song declared the U.S. national anthem.




