NEW PARKS EVENT USAGE POLICY

The City of Taneytown is in the process of drafting a new Parks Usage Agreement for organizations that want to use the parks for special events. There will be an agreement that needs to be signed by the organization that is requesting the use of the park and also certain requirements that need to be met in a certain time frame before the date of the event. Insurance certificates, food permits, promotional flyers along with any social media advertising and any items that will be sold for the purpose of fundraising must be approved by the City prior to any event. WATER/SEWER BILLS

Water/sewer bills will be issued April 1st with a due date of April 30th. Any bill not paid by the 30th will be assessed a 10% late penalty fee and will be due by May 17th by 3:00 PM. Water shut-off will be scheduled after May 18th, 2016. If water service is interrupted for non-payment, there will be an additional restoration fee of \$50 to reconnect water service. Questions regarding your bill can be directed to the City Finance office at 410-751-1100.

- Stop by in person, the City Office at 17 E. Baltimore Street is open from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm
- Drop your payment in our drop box located on the front of our building on the right
- Mail your payment to our office
- Pay online at www.taneytown.org (there is a \$6.95 convenience fee for every \$250)

MONTHLY PRE-PAYMENT PLAN

Please keep in mind, paying monthly on your water/sewer bill account continues to be an option for your household budget. Please be sure your account number is referenced at time of payment. All payments collected prior to the quarterly billing will be reflected on your account with the net balance due. Any over payments will remain on your account as a credit toward your next quarterly bill. If you want an annual average, please call City Finance office at 410-751-1100.

WATER AND SEWER RATES

The water rate is \$7.37 per 1,000 gallons and the sewer rate is \$14.48 per 1,000 gallons. The rate is based on the adopted resolution passed in 2011 to fund low interest rate loans secured to pay for needed public water and sewer improvement projects. Questions regarding the rate can be directed to the City Finance office at 410-751-1100.

DEAR PROPERTY OWNERS:

The City of Taneytown would like to take this opportunity to clarify the policy on estimated water bills. We obtain quarterly water readings remotely via a radio read. We do not need to enter your home for this reading.

If we are unable to obtain the radio read an estimated usage bill is calculated and mailed with the following note: METER CHECK DUE NOW - CALL ASAP. This is typically caused by a battery failure or a battery that is about to fail and requires us to enter your home.

If your bill has this note, please contact the City office at 410-751-1100, immediately, so that we can schedule a time to physically check the meter, obtain an actual read and/or complete needed repair, so we can obtain future radio reads. This process should take approximately 10-15 minutes. All you need to do is allow us a clear passage to your water meter in your home.

WEEK OF MAY 9, 2016

All City street curbs will be swept the week of May 9, 2016. Sweeping will begin in all developments north of Roberts Mill Road. Sweeping will then be moving from the eastside of the city to the westside, until completed. Please park vehicles in your driveway until sweeping is completed on your street. Thank you for your cooperation.

Vehicles are prohibited from parking on the posted no-parking streets between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. Vehicles that are not moved during this time period will be issued a parking citation. Residents may park their vehicles in the municipal parking lot on Record Lane or in the rear parking lot of the Police Station. Thank you for your cooperation.

TRASH AND RECYCLING REMINDER:

- Week of Memorial Day: Collection

will take place on Thursday, June 2, 2016 instead of Wednesday, June 1, 2016.

Please set your trash and recycling out the night before the above scheduled collection. Hughes Trash & Recycling will have additional equipment and personnel picking up much earlier than normal.

Please be reminded, trash collection is for household garbage only. The City's hauling company will not collect yard waste material.

RECYCLING REMINDER:

As we head into summer, spending time outdoors with family and friends, gathering together for picnics, please remember to recycle as many items as possible. The 64 gallon container the city has provided for recycling allows the necessary space for easy disposal. The city pays a tipping fee for household garbage that is taken to landfill, but not for recycling items that are collected separately. The more we recycle, the more we can save. Carroll County has recently approved, a tipping fee increase from \$62.00 to \$64.00 per ton.

YARD WASTE

Beginning in April and continuing through November, the Public Works Department will again pick up grass clippings on Tuesdays. You must call the City Office no later than 3 p.m. Monday to schedule for pick up the next day. Currently there are no charges to Carroll County residents for disposal of yard waste, at the

season long. I am excited about the amount of "grass roots" energy that is evident all over town. Our Main Street business community has come together with events and promotions that will keep us occupied for the rest of the year. A new group has formed, "Taneytown for the Arts". This is a group that will focus on the many local artists in and around Taneytown and showcase their talents at various events and showings throughout the year. The inaugural event was held on Friday March 18, featuring hometown artist David Hammond, who will exhibit some of his works at his shop, Vintage Colors, on East Baltimore St. Another exciting plan is in the works, in order to instill pride in our hometown, Taneytown. Councilman Joe Vigliotti brought before the full Council an idea of creating a program to recognize citizens and businesses that show pride in their hometown by the way they participate in city life, maintain their businesses and residences and generally promote the City and her people. Joe already has many who are on board with this idea, including your city Council. The name given to the project, is "Taneytown, A Shining City". I encourage you to get involved in the excitement. Contact Joe (javigliotti@gmail.com) or Councilman Brad Wantz (bjwantz@yahoo.com) or Economic Development Director Nancy McCormick (nbmccormick@taneytown.org) to see how you may help.

In Council news, we have truly accomplished much since I last wrote this column. I mentioned last time that Council was considering adding campaign finance reporting requirements for candidates for public office. This legislation was passed at the March Council meeting and will go a long way to ensure local elected office will be available to everyone who is willing to serve. It will also guarantee transparency and keep our elections, non-partisan. This action was necessary because in recent elections political action committees and other "out of Taneytown" groups and individuals have attempted to field special interest candidates with agendas with a particular partisan slant. It is important for all citizens to know where a candidate gets his/her support. Campaign finance reporting will ensure this. Also coming up for future Council action will be two items related to this. One concerns how we would remove someone from office for impropriety. Another has to do with the proper "code of conduct" for elected officials. I know the Council would like your input on either or both of these issues. You may view the sample resolutions on our web site (www.taneytown.org).

On the state level, this session of the General Assembly has been a wild one. The legislature will meet until April 11th (Sine Die) and there have been an unusually large amount of legislation filed. I have had the privilege of serving on the Maryland Municipal League's (MML) legislative committee for many years and I don't remember a session with so

many bills. The charge of the legislative committee is to be a "watch dog" of sorts and be on the lookout for bills that could prove detrimental to municipal citizens, and although there have been many such bills, the committee and MML staff has done a good job protecting our citizens. Another important function of the committee is to introduce legislation that will benefit municipalities throughout the state. For the last several years (since 2008) we have been lobbying the legislature to restore highway user revenues (HURs) that are collected from state gasoline taxes and vehicle related fees, to a predictable level, determined by a set formula (in place since the 1920s). The previous administration "raided" this fund in order to balance their budget shortfalls. These funds have not been restored completely, but in recent years have grown a little bit each year. The funds are earmarked to maintain our city roads. The committee's goal is to pass legislation fully restoring these funds. We (MML) have introduced bills in the house & senate aimed at this purpose. With the bi-partisan support of many legislators and the support of the Hogan administration, we remain optimistic that we may be able to accomplish this goal. If you have a chance to interact with any legislator, please encourage them to support MML's effort to enable us to be able to fix our roads.

Well, it is now time for the History Quiz! Each issue we explore Taneytown's rich history by encour-

debris into the street. This practice can block downstream storm water inlet grates and pipes causing storm water to backup into the street, creating flooding conditions. Also, please report anyone seen dumping materials into the storm water drainage system, by contacting the Taneytown Police Department (410-751-1150) or the City Office (410-751-1100). It could be contaminating our environment.

BULK TRASH - SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2016:

From 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. the City will provide compaction trucks and dumpsters at Taneytown Memorial Park for the removal of bulk trash. Citizens are asked to observe the following procedures:

- Citizens will be responsible for bringing their trash to the park for disposal.
- All persons who are dumping material will be required to show proper ID to the attendants, before they can drop off their items. Only citizens of Taneytown will be allowed to

CROUSE FORD RENOVATIONS

The decision to embark on a full facilities renovation was made December of 2014 in order to modernize the appearance and functionality of our dealership that has served us well for the past thirty years. The present building that houses our service, parts department, paint and body, administrative offices and Sales showroom was built in 1985 and was due for a makeover.

Ford's Trust Mark program offered planning and financial assistance to dealers wishing to make the desired improvements.

Ford Motor Company had basic requirements to meet including the addition of a 29-foot tall Entry Tower, Showroom Vestibule, exterior Architectural Aluminum Paneling, and new LED-lit exterior signage. Other requirements were to install a customer friendly WI-FI service, paint all exterior surfaces of the existing building as well as the interior to achieve a welcoming environment.

Crouse Ford's other goals were to add a 400 square foot customer lounge, enlarge the showroom space for a dedicated finance office, completely change the customer

restrooms, widen the hallway, install Epoxy-based flooring at the service reception area, install new ceilings with efficient LED lighting, and to install new 24 inch ceramic tile flooring and carpeting.

Conewago Contractors from Hanover, PA would serve as the General Contractor. The first stage of construction was "de-construction". The demo phase began on June 22, 2015 and included the removal of the old ceiling tile, lights, and the original wooden wall-paneling. Two mobile air conditioned trailers served as the restroom and waiting area for customers waiting on vehicle service. Crouse Ford was very grateful to all customers and employees who showed patience and understanding throughout this entire process.

The next stage was the demo and installation of new Showroom glass storefronts and glass entrance doors. During late summer of 2015 we witnessed the construction of new office and showroom walls, door frames and doors. The final touches were carried out with painting the new interior walls a lighter shade of Ford approved paint "Swiss Coffee". Customers have commented they like the appearance of the brighter showroom.

Also, new pencil-wood surfaces, and "blue-moon" Quartz counter tops were installed throughout, including parts and service counters, coffee bar, and restrooms. All had to match the Ford furniture that started to arrive in a series of three shipments. The first shipment included all-new customer appointment stations in our service department.

The final delivery of furniture arrived in late December making for a nice Christmas present. Customer reaction to the changed dealership facilities have been very well received. Completion of renovations will help Crouse Ford mark their 75th Anniversary this Spring.



dispose of trash. All others will be turned away.

- Please do not leave trash in the park after hours specified above. The trash disposal service will only operate during these hours.

- Vehicles transporting bulk trash for disposal must be limited to passenger vehicles and pickup trucks. Larger trucks should haul their items directly to the Carroll County Landfill.

- All items containing oil and/or gas must be drained.

- The attendant will direct you to dedicated dumpsters for metal items and appliances only.

- There will be one compaction truck designated for all other acceptable recyclable items, which includes little tyke play equipment, plastic trash cans, etc.

- To keep the flow of traffic moving, all recycling items should be separated before entering the drop-off area.

- Dirt, sod, tires, propane tanks, paint,

or chemicals of any type, will not be accepted.

- Yard waste will be limited to grass clippings, flower & shrubbery trimmings only, and must be placed in paper kraft bags.

- Batteries will also be accepted.

- This will be the only bulk trash event for 2016, so please have your unwanted items ready for disposal this spring.

FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING

The City's Water Department will be Flushing fire hydrants in the areas listed below. City hydrants are flushed regularly to ensure they are in working order for fire protection, and to remove sediment in pipes. These sediments, which do not pose a health concern, are comprised mostly of minerals which have accumulated over time. The annual flushing program helps to keep fresh and clear water throughout the distribution system. Customers may notice a slight drop in water pressure or temporary water discoloration. Restaurants and those using washing machines are cautioned to check their water supply. If tap water does become discolored, turn on several cold-







APRIL 30, 2016 11:00 A.M.

The Taneytown Heritage & Museum Association, Inc. will be celebrating the Grand Opening of the History Museum at the new location, 340 East Baltimore Street, Taneytown, Md. with a weekend of celebration. The opening ceremony and ribbon cutting will be held on Saturday, April 30th, 11:00 a.m. with the museum remaining open until 4 p.m.

The museum will also be open on Sunday, May 1st, 1:00 - 4:00 p.m.

The kickoff for the grand opening and ribbon cutting will begin promptly at 11 a.m. There will be some brief remarks by some local dignitaries. Following the remarks, the museum will officially be open to the public. There is no charge for admission. Volunteers and Docents will be available to answer questions and as guides as you tour the new museum.

Today is a new beginning for the History Museum, and in August 2016 will be the 12 year anniversary. Some brief history of the museum's beginning existence. What began as a dream by George Crouse and George Naylor to initiate plans to develop a history museum came to fruition in 2004 when they negotiated a lease with the City of Taneytown for a building owned by the city. Modifications were made to the building and the museum officially opened at 24 E. Baltimore Street in 2004 in time for the 250th Taneytown Anniversary.

The museum obtained non-profit status with the Community Foundation of Carroll County.

In 2012 the museum had to close as the lease was about to expire and accessibility standards had been cited. All exhibits that were on loan to the museum were returned to their owners and furniture and supplies placed in storage.

In 2013 the Taneytown Heritage Committee and Taneytown History Museum were aware they shared common interests, goals and many of the same members.

The Museum Committee and Heritage Committee merged in 2014 and with a new name,

The Taneytown Heritage & Museum Association, Inc. TH&MA, Inc. is a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization.

In October 2013 a benefactor came forward with a gift for the property at 340 East Baltimore Street. This was a very well maintained home and had historic significance as it was formerly the home of the Taneytown Hudson car dealership. Immediately plans were being made for renovations to make a safe and accessible facility for all to house the museum. Architects were consulted, contracts were awarded for renovations and over the many months the museum renovations have been completed including addition of an accessibility ramp, new parking lot, landscaping, many updates both inside and outside the property and many other features.

TH&MA is an entirely volunteer community project. Many hours of research, planning, meetings and setting up exhibits have been involved. This new and improved museum has been in the making for the past 2 years and it is well worth the wait. The volunteers have been working day and night to prepare the museum. Nearly all of the artifacts on display are on loan to the museum. The museum has a reference library and collects and preserves paper memorabilia and ephemera that pertains to Taneytown and the surrounding area.

Light refreshments will be available along with a souvenir for each person. We are pleased to have a Hudson car on display at the museum property on April 30.

Parking is available at the Northwest Middle School which adjoins the museum property. There is a walkway from the school property. The address for parking is 99 Kings Drive which can be accessed from E. Baltimore Street to Trevanion Road at the light. Kings Drive will be on the left. For those needing accessible parking there is designated parking at the museum property.

Everyone is encouraged to come out and enjoy this very special historic event for the museum and the Taneytown community.




