## MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Ahh, good advice, particularly as your Mayor and Council deal with next year's budget. It has been a real struggle dealing with the budgeting process this year, as I expected, but more about that later. Meanwhile, I have great news! I am writing these remarks on the first day of spring! I don't think I have ever been so glad to see winter depart! Speaking of budgets, this winter has been a real budget buster, to the tune of an estimated \$50,000! That's a big figure to be over budget, but proper planning and being under budget for the last several years will ease the impact somewhat. Springtime brings newness, new life, warmer weather more leisure time to spend with the family. I know of no better tonic for "cabin fever" than a few warm and sunny days.

We are about to welcome several new and expanded businesses to Taneytown. Carroll Hospital Center has opened a primary care facility in the shopping center next to Peebles Department Store. The new Sheetz facility will be opening soon, at the traffic circle, Lorien Heath Care has expanded and is now offering assisted living facilities on Antrim Blvd. Lorien will be featuring an open to the public lite fair restaurant called Flick's Pub. 

## PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

### 2014 HOLIDAY TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE:

- Week of Memorial Day: Collection will take place on Thursday, May 29, 2014, instead of Wednesday, May 28th.
- Week of Labor Day: Collection will take place on Thursday, September 4, 2014, instead of Wednesday, September 3rd.

Trash and recycling will be collected on its normal scheduled day CHRISTMAS EVE & NEW YEARS EVE.

Please set your trash and recycling out the night before the above scheduled collections. Hughes Trash & Recycling will have additional equipment and personnel picking up much earlier than normal.

### YARD WASTE REMINDER:

From March through September, the Public Works Department provides weekly pick up of grass clippings on Tuesdays. Remember; you must call the City Office no later than 3 p.m. the Monday before the Tuesday you wish to have yard waste collected. Currently there are no charges to Carroll County residents for disposal of yard waste, at the County Landfill in Westminster (410) 386-4550:

- Please place your bags at the curb by 7:30 a.m., the morning of pick up.
- Yard waste must be placed in paper/kraft bags only.
- Please limit the weight of bags so they can easily be lifted for loading and unloading without bag breakage.
- This service is limited to grass clippings, flower & shrubbery trimmings only. Please do not dispose of tree branches, dirt, sod, thistle, or household garbage.

### TREE BRANCHES:

An open top container has been

placed on the parking lot, across from the football field on Park Road. Residents of Taneytown may dispose of tree branches that were broken off during the ice storm that occurred in February. ONLY RESIDENTS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF TANEYTOWN WILL BE ALLOWED TO DISPOSE OF TREE BRANCHES.

### BULK TRASH

SATURDAY, MAY 3, 2014: From 7 a.m. to 1 p.m., the City will provide compaction trucks and dumpsters at Taneytown Memorial Park for the removal of bulk trash. Citizens are asked to observe the following procedures:

- Citizens will be responsible for bringing their trash to the park for disposal.
- All persons who are dumping material will be required to show proper ID to the attendants, before they can drop off their items. Only citizens of Taneytown will be allowed to dispose of trash. All others will be turned away.
- Please do not leave trash in the park after hours specified above. The trash disposal service will only operate during these hours.
- Vehicles transporting bulk trash for disposal must be limited to passenger vehicles and pickup trucks. Larger trucks should haul their items directly to the Carroll County Landfill.
- All items containing oil and/or gas must be drained.
- The attendant will direct you to dedicated dumpsters for metal items and appliances only.
- There will be one compaction truck designated for all other acceptable recyclable items, which includes little tyke play equipment, plastic trash cans, etc.
- To keep the flow of traffic moving, all recycling items should be separated before entering the drop-off area.
- Dirt, sod, tires, propane tanks, paint, or chemicals of any type, will not be accepted.

on 340 E Baltimore St. Comcast, our cable TV/internet provider will provide grant incentives for all the volunteers who participate that day. This will directly benefit the Museum. We look to begin about 11AM and hope to be finished by about 3PM (tentative times). Make plans to come out, participate and be counted! You don't have to stay the whole time, but anytime you could devote will help the museum. We are still in the planning stage as I write this, but watch our web site and cable channel 23 for further details or contact Nancy McCormick in the City office at 410-751-1100.

I began by talking about the struggle we are having arriving at a realistic budget. The economic times may be improving, but we sure have a long way to go. On a high note, we have been (MML) advocating full restoration of the highway user revenues (HURs) that were stripped by the O'Malley administration early in its tenure. We again this year have received additional funds to help repair our city's roads. A little over \$181,000 will be restored to use this year, in total SHA funds. This is up about 5% over last year but still only about 50% of historic funding levels. We are thankful for these funds. Police aid, also a return of tax dollars by the State to local government that was impacted by the administration has been restored fully, +1%! It takes more than HUR's & Police Aid to fund the budget, though. Property taxes took a hit because of lower assessed values. The housing market is showing signs of some recovery, so we hope, at least with the coming round of new assessments, we won't experience a decline of the magnitude we last felt. There too, has been some building activity, mostly at Creek Side near Food Lion, which increases our tax base. Welcome new taxpayers. We are glad you choose Taneytown for your home! We will get through these trials and tribulations, and hopefully arrive at a budget we all can be comfortable with. Public meeting to discuss the budget will be held at the

April and May council workshop/meetings. Check our web site ([www.taneytown.org](http://www.taneytown.org)) for complete details. We could use your input!

I mentioned in the last column in the Record that Taneytown was faced with a homelessness problem for the first time in my memory. To update you, we are continuing to meet with local concerned citizens, county and state advocacy groups. The Great Recession continues to impact us all.

In other activities this winter I was able to once again represent Taneytown as a member of the MD Municipal League's (MML) legislative committee. This committee meets weekly during the session, although I did take a couple of snow days. This year's legislative session, being an election year, saw less onerous tax bills come before us (although there were some) and we were able to focus on restoration of funds stripped by the administration. The "Rain Tax" (SWM Fee) has been temporarily put to rest from the county's perspective, but this tax still looms for municipalities. We have a continuing dialogue with the county to address this issue. Each year I look forward to the time I spend with the fourth grade students at Taneytown Elementary School. I talk to them about municipal government and invite them to participate in a state-wide essay contest entitled "If I were Mayor". The students are asked to write a short essay and let me know how they might run the City, if they had the opportunity. It is always a joy to read the comments. The winner wins lunch, a \$100 prize, a trip to Annapolis, recognition by the Lt. Governor and a harbor cruise. The contest is open to all MD fourth graders (the home schooled & private/parochial schools are included), but if you have a fourth grader that wants to participate, time is short. Entries must be postmarked by 3/31. Speaking of contests, you may recall from last month's Mayor's Comments, I started a Local History Quiz. I invited the kids to answer a question about the history of Taneytown and the surrounding area. Last month's question was: Who were the first inhabitants of the Taneytown area? The answer was: Native Americans. The one who responded with the first correct answer was Gracie Bradley, of Taneytown. Congratulations Gracie, for your correct answer. Gracie won a \$25 gift card. Thanks to all the kids who participated.

- Yard waste will be limited to grass clippings, flower & shrubbery trimmings only, and must be placed in paper/kraft bags.
- Batteries will also be accepted.
- This will be the only bulk trash event for 2014, so please have your unwanted items ready for disposal this spring.

### FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING

The City's Water Department will be flushing fire hydrants in the areas listed below. This process helps clean, remove sediment and release trapped air from the water distribution system, and also verifies proper operation of the fire hydrant. Customers in these areas, especially restaurants and those using washing machines are cautioned to check their water supply for rusty water, which may occur. You can open your cold water tap and run for several minutes until the water clears.

## THE FILTHY FACTS ABOUT FEROCIOUS FLEAS!

Hello, it's Katie with Antrim Veterinary Hospital! Has Fido or Fluffy started scratching incessantly, developing scabs, or losing patches of fur? If so then your pet may have a problem with fleas. Think you know all about fleas and how to keep them at bay? Think again! Below you will find out the truth about those pesky parasites.

**Myth #1:** Fleas live on pets, not in houses. **Fact:** Fleas have no problem making themselves at home in your house. Fleas usually enter the house on pets but they don't waste any time finding shelter in carpets, basements, furniture and bedding. If you have fleas in the house it is imperative to take quick action in treating all areas with an insect growth regulator as this will take care of all stages of the flea lifecycle, except the pupae. There are no available products that kill the pupae stage.

**Myth #2:** Keeping the house clean will prevent fleas from making themselves at home. **Fact:** Fleas enjoy even the most spotless home; they can be quite comfortable nesting in cracks in the floor, baseboards, furniture and area rugs. Keep all pets in the household on monthly preventatives.

**Myth #3:** I saw a flea on my pet but it's not a big problem. **Fact:** The majority of a flea population consists of the larval, egg or pupae stages, all which take place off of the pet. A single flea can lay 50 eggs per day, approximately 500 eggs in it's lifetime. The eggs may take up to 3 months to hatch, which may not be an issue at the moment but if not treated can cause an infestation down the road.

**Myth #4:** I do not need to treat my pet for fleas during winter months. **Fact:** In our area fleas are present year round. Although they may slow down in the winter one warm day can bring them out again. It is imperative to treat all pets in the household every 30 days year round to assure optimal protection.

The MDE dropped the \$10,000.00 penalty against Carroll regarding the Rain Tax, recognizing that because Carroll has the funding budgeted and is in compliance with our permit, we do not need an additional tax. The state would simply like to see us show on our tax bills the portion of the property tax that is spent on storm water management operating costs. So don't panic when you see the breakout of a couple of cents on your tax bill, it is not new money. This practice

Fleas can be anywhere and on any pet. Even indoor pets can get fleas. Just because you are not seeing fleas, it doesn't mean they are not there. Just one flea can cause a whole lot of itching for a flea allergic pet. Maybe you are treating your pet with a preventative every 30 days and still seeing fleas. Why does this happen? Flea products do not avert fleas from jumping on your pet, however they are very effective in killing newly arrived fleas within 12 - 24 hours. When fleas are affected you may see them come to the top of the hair coat and may see them moving more slowly. Healthy non-affected fleas are hard to spot and move very quickly. It is impossible for a flea prevention product to control a flea infestation overnight. You must treat the house and all pets that come in contact with your home. Contact your veterinarian or stop by Antrim Veterinary Hospital and make sure your pet is protected this spring.
