WATER/SEWER BILLS

Water/sewer bills will be issued July 1st with a due date of July 31st. Any bill not paid by 3:00 PM on the 31st will be assessed a 10% late penalty fee and will be due by August 17th by 3:00 PM. Water shut-off will be scheduled after August 18th, 2015. If water service is interrupted for non-payment, there will be an additional restoration fee of \$50 to reconnect water service. Questions regarding your bill can be directed to the City Finance office at 410-751-1100.

WATER AND SEWER RATES INCREASE

Effective with the quarterly billing period beginning July 1, 2015, water and sewer rates will increase. The new rate will be reflected on the bill for the quarter ending September 30, 2015. Please keep in mind that if final reads are requested after July 1, 2015 the new rates will apply. The new water rate will be \$7.37 per 1,000 gallons and the sewer rate will be at \$14.48 per 1,000 gallons. The rate increase is based on the adopted resolution passed in 2011 to fund low interest rate loans secured to pay for needed public water and sewer improvement projects. Questions regarding the increase can be directed to the City Finance office at 410-751-1100.

ONLINE BILL PAYMENT SERVICES

The City does not currently accept funds electronically through Online Bill Pay. The Bill Pay will print a check and mail it to the billing address. For some checks, the money for the payment is withdrawn on the pay date. For others, the money is withdrawn when the City deposits the check.

To ensure payment is mailed to us prior to the due date, schedule your payment at least 5 business days before the stated due date. Business Days are Monday through Friday (non-business days are Saturday, Sunday and federal holidays).

DEAR PROPERTY OWNERS:

The City of Taneytown would like to take this opportunity to clarify the policy on estimated water bills. We obtain quarterly water readings remotely via a radio read. We do not need to enter your home for this reading.

If we are unable to obtain the radio read an estimated usage bill is calculated and mailed with the following note: **METER CHECK DUE NOW - CALL ASAP.** This is typically caused by a battery failure and requires us to enter your home.

If your bill has this note, please contact the City office at 410-751-1100, immediately, so that we can schedule a time to physically check the meter, obtain an actual read and/or complete needed repair, so we can obtain future radio reads. This process should take approximately 10 - 15 minutes. All you need to do is allow us a clear passage to your water meter in your home. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

TRASH AND RECYCLING REMINDER

Week of Independence Day: No change; Collection will take place on the normally schedule day of Wednesday, July 1, 2015

YARD WASTE REMINDER

You must call the City Office no

later than 3 p.m. Monday to schedule for pick up the next day. Currently there are no charges to Carroll County residents for disposal of yard waste at the County Landfill in Westminster (410) 386-4550.

- Please place your bags at the curb by 7:30 a.m., the morning of pick up.
- Yard waste must be placed in paper-kraft bags only.
- Please limit the weight of bags so they can easily be lifted for loading and unloading without bag breakage.
- This service is limited to grass clippings, flower & shrubbery trimmings only. Please do not dispose of dirt, sod, thistle, or household garbage.

GRASS CLIPPINGS

Please do not sweep or blow grass and debris into the street. This practice can block downstream storm water inlet grates and pipes causing storm water to backup into the street, creating flooding conditions. Also, please report anyone seen dumping materials into the storm water drainage system, by contacting the Taneytown Police Department (410-751-1150) or the City Office (410-751-1100). It could be contaminating our environment.

lessly been at your service during their terms of office and I am sure their spirit of service will continue in the coming years. Thank you Carl & Rick for your many years of unselfish service. The new Council was seated at the close of Old Business at our May Council Meeting. One of the last acts performed by the old Council was to enact the fiscal year 2016 budget (effective 6/30/15). The budget passed unanimously. I am proud to say we were able to fund the City's services again, this year, without a tax increase. In other Council news, a new well, Well 17 in now ready to be put into service. The improvements required by Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) that will upgrade our waste water treatment plant are well under way. 

CODE ENFORCEMENT REMINDERS

When the streets blossom with neon orange, green and yellow tag-board signs, it must be yard sale season! Please keep in mind that off-premise signs are prohibited by City Code. Yard sale signs are

permitted in all zones of the City, but they must be on the property where the sale is being conducted, according to section 205-44.E. Signs on parked vehicles are not allowed as described in section 205-53.K. "Prohibited Signs". The off-premise limitations also apply to new home and other real estate directional signs.

The City Code does provide for a fine of "not more than \$100.00" for such a violation. The Code also tells us that each and every day a violation continues

may be deemed a separate offense, and each sign is considered a separate offense. The goal here is not to issue citations, but to gain compliance with the code, and I hope it does not become necessary to step things up and levy fines because of continued noncompliance.

This is also a busy time of year for complaints regarding yard maintenance, or rather lack of maintenance. Weeds and Grass need to be kept under control, with

the City Code specifying that property owners or occupants not allow property to become overgrown, which is defined basically as weeds or other plants over 8 inches high. Trees are exempt from this requirement provided they are not growing wild, and plants grown for cultivation or ornamental purposes are also exempt. Property that becomes overgrown, may be considered "detrimental to health,







safety, or welfare or the inhabitants of the city" according to Chapter 124 Article III of the City Code. When you do mow, please do not discharge or blow grass clippings onto the sidewalk or into the street where they may block storm drains. Yes, that's a violation of City code as well! Properties that either become overgrown or accumulate refuse or rubbish may also be providing a habitat for rodents, and feral cats, which of course tend also to trigger complaints. Consider also, that harboring animals, according to Animal Control Ordinances adopted by the City basically makes someone who harbors an animal the animal's owner - just something to think about before sitting food or water out for strays that may come around your property.

The City of Taneytown – Public Works Department would like to present to you this year's Annual Water Quality Report. This report is designed to inform you about the quality of the water and services we deliver to you every day and to help you understand the efforts we make to continuously improve the water treatment process and protect our water resources. Our constant goal is to provide you with a safe and dependable supply of drinking water. We are committed to ensuring the quality of your water.

Our water is supplied by seven wells located throughout the City, which draw from the New Oxford aquifer (or Formation). Each well has its own chlorine disinfection treatment system. The finished (treated) water from each well is pumped into a distribution piping system, which includes two storage tanks.

We have a Source Water Assessment Plan available from our office that provides more information such as potential sources of contamination. This plan is also available from Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) or at the Carroll County Public Library.

We are pleased to report that our drinking water meets federal and state requirements.

Some people may be more vulnerable to contaminants in drinking water than the general population. Immuno-compromised persons such as persons with cancer undergoing chemotherapy, persons who have undergone organ transplants, people with HIV/AIDS or other immune system disorders, some elderly, and infants can be particularly at risk for infections. These people should seek advice about drinking water from their health care providers. EPA/CDC guidelines on appropriate means to lessen the risk of infection by cryptosporidium and other microbiological contaminants are available from the Environmental Protection Agency's Safe Drinking Water (SDW) Hotline (800-426-4791).

If you have any questions about this report or concerning your water utility, please contact the City Office at 410-751-1100 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. We want our valued customers to be informed about their water utility. If you want to learn more, please attend any of our regularly scheduled Council meetings. They are held on the second Monday of each month at 7:30 p.m. at the City Office.

We have learned through our monitoring and testing that some contaminants have been detected in the City's drinking water supply. As water travels over the land or underground, it can pick up substances or contaminants such as microbes, inorganic and organic chemicals, and radioactive substances. All sources of drinking water are subject to potential contamination by substances that are naturally occurring or man made. All drinking water, including bottled water may reasonably be expected to contain at least small amounts of some contaminants. The presence of

contaminants does not necessarily indicate that the water poses a health risk. More information about contaminants and potential health effects can be obtained by calling the SDW Hotline at 1-800-426-4791.

The City of Taneytown routinely monitors for contaminants in your drinking water according to Federal and State laws. The following table shows the results of our monitoring for the period of January 1st to December 31st, 2014. In this table, you will find many terms and abbreviations you might not be familiar with. To help you better understand these terms, we've provided the following definitions:

- Non-Detect (ND)** - laboratory analysis indicates that the contaminant is not present.
- Parts per million (ppm) or Milligrams per liter (mg/l)** - one part per million corresponds to one minute in two years or a single penny in \$10,000.
- Parts per billion (ppb) or Micrograms per liter** - one part per billion corresponds to one minute in 2,000 years, or a single penny in \$10,000,000.
- Picocuries per liter (pCi/L)** - Picocuries per liter is a measure of the radioactivity in water.
- Maximum Contaminant Level** - The "Maximum Allowed" (MCL) is the highest level of a contaminant that is allowed in drinking water. MCLs are set as close to the MCLGs as feasible using the best available treatment technology.
- Maximum Contaminant Level Goal** - The "Goal" (MCLG) is the level of a contaminant in drinking water below which there is no known or expected risk to health. MCLGs allow for a margin of safety.

Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL): EPA generally sets MCLs at levels that will result in no adverse health effects for some contaminants or a one-in-ten-thousand to one-in-a-million chance of having the described health effect for other contaminants.

Hardness: Water is a strong solvent that dissolves varying amounts of mineral substances. Calcium and magnesium are the principle mineral contaminants that cause water to be "hard." The average hardness, system-wide, in Taneytown is 230 ppm (17.1 ppm = 1 grain). While not a health concern, high levels of hardness can cause other issues such as spots on dishes and the need to use extra soap for bathing, dishes, laundry, and hot water heating.

Lead: If present, elevated levels of lead can cause serious health problems, especially for pregnant women and young children. Lead in drinking water is primarily from materials and components associated with service lines and home plumbing. The City of Taneytown is responsible for providing high quality drinking water, but cannot control the variety of materials used in plumbing components. When your water has been sitting for several hours, you can minimize the potential for lead exposure by flushing your tap for 30 seconds to 2 minutes before using water for drinking or cooking. If you are concerned about lead in your drinking water, you may wish to have your water tested. Information on lead in drinking water, testing methods, and steps you can take to minimize exposure is available from the EPA SDW Hotline at 1-800-426-4791 or at <http://www.epa.gov/sdwwater/lead>.

Nitrate: Levels above 10 ppm in drinking water is a health risk for infants of less than six months of age. High nitrate levels in drinking water can cause blue baby syndrome. Nitrate levels may rise quickly for short periods of time because of rainfall or agricultural activities. If you are caring for an infant you should ask advice from your health care provider.

Thank you for allowing us to continue providing your family with clean, quality water this year. In order to maintain a safe and dependable water supply we sometimes need to make improvements that will benefit all of our customers. These improvements are sometimes reflected as rate structure adjustments. Thank you for understanding.

We ask that all our consumers, who are the heart of our community, help us protect our water because our way of life and our children's future depends on it.


