WATER/SEWER BILLS

Water/sewer bills will be issued October 1st with a due date of October 30th. Any bill not paid by 3:00 PM on the 30th will be assessed a 10% late penalty fee and will be due by November 16th by 3:00 PM. Water shut-off will be scheduled after November 17th, 2015. If water service is interrupted for non-payment, there will be an additional restoration fee of \$50 to reconnect water service. Questions regarding your bill can be directed to the City Finance office at 410-751-1100.

MONTHLY PRE-PAYMENT PLAN

Please keep in mind, paying monthly on your water/sewer bill account continues to be an option for your household budget. Please be sure your account number is referenced at time of payment. All payments collected prior to the quarterly billing will be reflected on your account with the net balance due. Any over payments will remain on your account as a credit toward your next quarterly bill. If you want an annual average, please call City Finance office at 410-751-1100.

WATER AND SEWER RATES INCREASE

The new water rate is \$7.37 per 1,000 gallons and the sewer rate is \$14.48 per 1,000 gallons. The rate increase is based on the adopted resolution passed in 2011 to fund low interest rate loans secured to pay for needed public water and sewer improvement projects. Questions regarding the increase can be directed to the City Finance office at 410-751-1100.

DEAR PROPERTY OWNERS:

The City of Taneytown would like to take this opportunity to clarify the policy on estimated water bills. We obtain quarterly water readings remotely via a radio read. We do not need to enter your home for this reading.

If we are unable to obtain the radio read an estimated usage bill is calculated and mailed with the following note: **METER CHECK DUE NOW - CALL ASAP.** This is typically caused by a battery failure or a battery that is about to fail and requires us to enter your home.

If your bill has this note, please contact the City office at 410-751-1100, immediately, so that we can schedule a time to physically check the meter, obtain an actual read and/or complete needed repair, so we can obtain future radio reads. This process should take approximately 10 - 15 minutes. All you need to do is allow us a clear passage to your water meter in your home.

STREET SWEEPING SCHEDULE:

Monday, October 19, 2015

From 5AM to 10AM (no parking allowed):

- York, Frederick, East & West Baltimore Streets

Monday, November 16, 2015

From 5AM to 10AM (no parking allowed):

- York, Frederick, East & West Baltimore Streets

Vehicles are prohibited from parking on the posted no-parking streets between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. Vehicles that are not moved during this time period will be issued a parking citation. Residents may park their vehicles on the municipal parking lot on Record Lane or in the rear parking lot of the Police Station. Thank you for your cooperation.

TRASH & RECYCLING:

Week of Thanksgiving Day Holiday: NO CHANGE Collection will take place on its normal pick up day; Wednesday, November 25, 2015.

Please be reminded trash collection is for household garbage only. The City's hauling company will not collect yard waste or building materials. Recycling containers containing trash will not be picked-up.

LEAF PICK-UP

Curbside leaf pick-up will be provided once again this fall. This service will take place weekly on Tuesdays, from October 27, through December 1, 2015. Please pack the leaves in plastic bags only and place them at the curb by 7:30 a.m. Bags should not weigh more than 30 pounds each, providing the bags are strong enough to support that weight when lifting. Please limit bag size to 50 gallon. Leaves will be taken to local farms and used as compost, allowing the use of plastic bags. Bags must be tied, and contain LEAVES ONLY. No grass, tree branches, sod, or trash will be picked-up. DURING THE LEAF PICKUP SCHEDULE (Oct. 27 - Dec. 1) GRASS CLIPPINGS will be collected without scheduling for pick-up, but paper kraft bags are still required for grass clipping disposal.

INTERESTING RECYCLING FACTS

Here are a potpourri of interesting facts about recycling for your entertainment and education:

Interesting Recycling Facts / Water

- A running faucet wastes 2.5 gallons of water each minute.
- A dishwasher uses 11 gallons of water per use.

- 75 percent of all water used in the household is used in the bathroom.
- A toilet made in 1992 or earlier uses up to 60 percent more water per flush than newer high efficiency toilets.
- Turning off the tap while brushing your teeth in the morning and before bedtimes can save up to 8 gallons per day. This is a savings of 240 gallons per month.
- Running your faucet for 5 minutes uses up enough energy to run a 60 watt light bulb for 14 hours.
- A full bath tub uses 70 gallons of water. A 5 minute shower only uses 10-25 gallons.

INTERESTING RECYCLING FACTS / PAPER

- Recycling 1 ton of paper saves 17 mature trees, 7,000 gallons of water, 3 cubic yards of landfill space, 2 barrels of oil, and 4000 kilowatt hours of electricity. This is enough energy to power the average American home for 5 months.
- The process of recycling paper instead of making it from new materials generates 74 percent less air pollution and uses 50 percent less water.
- Manufacturing recycled paper uses 60

for; family, friends and "takin' it easy". BUT I'm back to work and I must say our City did not stop while we were away for those few days.

Much has been accomplished since I last wrote you. I have talked about a major capital project that is underway at our waste water treatment plant. We are making our plant compliant with the latest series of EPA/State mandates to reduce contaminants that will enter the bay. This project is well underway and should be completed before spring. We are on the cutting edge of new technology because of the equipment being installed there. The greater majority of the cost for these renovations is being provided by a grant by the MD Dept. of Environment (MDE). Still, the City has considerable investment in the project. The final result, a cleaner bay, will be worth the effort. Also, since my last article, Council has approved a new section of housing for development in Meadow Brook (Sec IV). This will bring new residents to the "small town with the big heart". Speaking of new, we have added three new eateries to our town! Recently opened have been Jenny's (old Bentley's location) Grandma's Gems (old Back Yard BBQ/Snowball Stand), and Broken Spoke (old Gunner's Grill). Make sure you stop in



meeting your water and sewer obligations, talk with us. You'll be surprised at what we can work out. Some more good news is that Taneytown is now part of the FEMA Emergency Flood Plain Management System. We had not been, before. Now property owners are able to take advantage of this nationwide flood insurance program. In other items that are to come before Council in the near future is the strengthening of our ethics laws that will actually assign penalties for those who violate the ethics standards. In this vein, new regulations are being considered to better regulate campaign financing. Currently we have none. Your input on these items, or any other issue facing our town, is always welcome. In an effort to make the actions of the various City's committee meetings and Council meetings, more available, we have begun recording many of these meetings. We still encourage your participation, by being part of the live audience, but if you can't make it on meeting night, you can always catch the action on our web site (www.taneytown.org). Again, we welcome your comments.

I am writing these remarks on September 17, Constitution Day, and my birthday, and the morning following the second session of the Republican Presi-

percent of the energy needed to make paper from new materials.

- Over 73 percent of all newspapers are recovered for recycling. About 33 percent of this is used to make newsprint the rest is used to make paperboard, tissue, or insulation.
- A little more than 48 percent of all office paper is recycled. This is used to make writing papers, paperboard, tissue, and insulation.

INTERESTING RECYCLING FACTS / METAL

- Recycling steel and tin cans saves 74 percent of the energy used to make them.
- Americans throw away enough aluminum every month to rebuild our entire commercial air fleet.
- Americans throw out enough iron and steel to continuously supply all the auto makers in the entire nation.
- A steel mill using recycled scrap reduces water pollution, air pollution, and mining waste by about 70 percent.
- When you throw away an aluminum can you waste as much energy as if you'd filled the can half full of gasoline and poured it into the ground.

MISSION OF MERCY FILLS COMMUNITY'S NEEDS

Thanks to cooperative community partnerships, Mission of Mercy will begin offering its free healthcare services one Saturday a month at their regular mobile clinic site at Trinity Evangelical Lutheran, 38 W. Baltimore St., Taneytown. The first clinic will be Saturday, October 3 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Primary healthcare and prescription medications will be offered at the Saturday clinic. No dental care will be available.

"Our thanks to Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church for working with us to add this second clinic day," noted Dr. Michael Sullivan, Mission of Mercy's Chief Medical Director.

For medical patient appointments call 410-833-5870. You must leave a message with a call back number. Medical patients without an appointment should come early in the morning to increase their chances of being seen on a walk-in basis.

Walk-in patients are not guaranteed to be seen and are based on availability.

"Economic development is all about a healthy community and developing partnerships. When you pull everyone together who knows what can happen!" says Nancy McCormick, the Economic Director of Taneytown and a long-time enthusiastic supporter of Mission of Mercy.

Last year M.O.M. provided more than 750 medical and dental patient visits in the Taneytown area.

"We're hearing that Taneytown, which has a population of 7 - 8,000 people, is one of the highest needs areas in the state," she explains.

One obvious need was for addi-



tional access to healthcare on weekends. Carroll Hospital Center's Emergency Department reported seeing a spike in visits on Friday nights and Saturdays from people living in the Taneytown area.

So Nancy pulled together Jennifer Charlton and David Liddle, from Mission of Mercy, Leslie Simmons, the new President of Carroll Hospital Systems, and Tammy Black, from Access Carroll County. As a result of the discussions, Mission of Mercy is offering the Saturday clinics.

"Carroll Hospital is fortunate to work with community partners like Mission of Mercy in Taneytown," says Leslie Simmons, president of Carroll Hospital. "Taneytown residents who are uninsured and underinsured benefit from having access to free health care services that are close to home."

"If we don't take care of those less fortunate, we'll have more and more people in need. People can't go to work if they don't feel good or are missing teeth," notes Nancy.

"Mission of Mercy makes us a healthier community. We're a community that pays it back - we have many giving individuals and organizations," she adds.

FUN FACTS ABOUT PAPER RECYCLING

- One ton of recycled paper saves 3.3 cubic yards of landfill space.
- De-inked paper fiber is the most efficient source of fiber for the manufacturing of new paper products. One ton of de-inked pulp saves over 7,000 gallons of water, 300 gallons of oil and reduces emissions by 90 pounds compared to traditional virgin paper processes.
- Enough paper is collected for recycling each year to make a basket from 7,000 miles long.
- One ton of recycled paper uses 40% less energy, 30% less water, emits 74% less air pollution and creates five times more jobs than one ton of paper products from virgin wood pulp.

Baltimore Waste Services Paper Retriever program in the Philadelphia area makes up a large part of the Paper Retriever program nationwide, which collects enough newspapers each year to completely cover 12.500 football fields in paper one inch deep.




