WATER/SEWER BILLS

Water/sewer bills will be issued October 1st with a due date of October 31st. Any bill not paid by 3:00 PM on the 31st will be assessed a 10% late penalty and will be due by November 17th by 3:00 PM. Water shut off will be scheduled after November 18th, 2014. If water service is interrupted for non-payment there will be an additional restoration fee of \$50 to reconnect water service.

The new water rate is \$6.53 per 1,000 gallons and the sewer rate is \$12.81 per 1,000 gallons. The rate increase is based on the adopted resolution passed in 2011 to fund low interest rate loans secured to pay for needed public water and sewer improvement projects. Questions regarding the increase can be directed to the City Finance department at 410-751-1100.

DEAR PROPERTY OWNERS:

The City of Taneytown would like to take this opportunity to clarify the policy for the payment of water/sewer bills for rental properties located in the City.

Bills are mailed to the property owner and we do not bill the tenant. The property owner is responsible for payment of the water/sewer charges. Water/sewer bills are issued on a quarterly basis. Water/sewer bills are mailed allowing a thirty-day payment period. Payments must be received at the City Office on or before the due date to avoid late fees. A 10% late fee is assessed to the unpaid balance if payment is not received by the due date.

Failure to pay the past due charges will result in the discontinuance of service after a two week grace period. Restoration fees will be assessed and all charges must be paid before water service will be restored.

Ultimately, the City holds the property owner responsible for paying utility bills and they will receive the original bill. We will not be responsible if we are forced to turn off water to a rental property due to nonpayment of one or more units.

STREET SWEEPING

Street sweeping on posted no parking areas along York, Frederick, East and West Baltimore Streets will take place on the third Monday of each month. Vehicles are prohibited from parking on the posted no parking streets between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. Vehicles that are not moved during this time period will be issued a parking citation. Residents may park their vehicles on the municipal parking lot on Record Lane or in the rear parking lot of the Police Station. Thank you for your cooperation.

LEAF PICK-UP

Curbside leaf pick-up will be provided once again this fall. This service will take place weekly on Tuesdays, from October 28, through December 2, 2014. Please pack the leaves in plastic bags only and place them at the curb by 7:30 a.m. Bags should not weigh more than 30 pounds each, providing the bags are strong enough to support that weight when lifting. Please limit bag size to 50 gallon. Leaves will be taken to local farms and used as compost, allowing the use of plastic bags. Bags must be tied, and contain LEAVES ONLY. No grass, tree branches, sod, or trash will be picked-

The shop owners and other business people will be welcoming the "Pumpkin People" back to town. Make sure you take the kids around town to see our visitors, they won't stay too long. Make sure you pick the ones you like the best! We just finished celebrating "Family Fun Days" this past weekend in Taneytown. I thank the Lions Club for producing this event. The event had it all; dancers, music, petting zoo, car show, great food and fireworks. Not to mention the Dunking Booth! I spent my time there. I must say, I spent most of that time "in the tank"! It was great fun and most importantly, the Lions were able to raise money to help our community. Did you know that all the money that the Taneytown Lions Club raises is used for community projects and stays right here in town! Next time you see a Lion (club member, that is) say THANKS. Thinking about becoming more involved in the community, joining the Lions Club is a great place to start.. but wait a minute, the fun is not over just yet. Coming up on October 18th is our annual Harvest Fest Celebration. This year promises to be bigger and better than ever. We will have craft vendors, good food, a Pet Parade and the ever popular "Barnyard Bingo" (see separate article or our web site for the details). So if you have other plans for Saturday the 18th of October you may want to change them and come on down to Memorial Park for a day of family fun.

The business of running our City has kept your Council and I busy since I last visited with you here. I was able to attend the annual fall conference for the Maryland Municipal League in Annapolis recently. The event was attended by municipal officials from all over the state. A wealth of usable knowledge is gained at events like this. This time spent with elected officials from every size town is priceless. One of the main purposes of this meeting was to discuss the Maryland Municipal League's (MML) legislative priorities for the coming legislative session that begins Jan., 2015. Again this year we are seeking to have restored, the funds traditionally allotted to us for maintenance of our roads (aka Highway User Revenues or HUR's). I have talked about this many times, before, in this column, and we have achieved partial success. The job is not done, however. The current O'Malley/Brown administration and General Assembly, took these funds from local government early on in the administrations tenure. They have only been partially restored. We seek to reinstate or establish, a formula that would assure us of a certain amount of funds for highway repairs, etc., similar to what we have had in the past. In another bit of news Taneytown received an award from the State for improvement in energy efficiency.

This reminds me that it is time once again to elect our state and county government. On November 4th this year we will elect a Governor and Lt. Governor, members for the House of Delegates and the MD Senate, a State Attorney General, a Comptroller, County Commissioners, a School Board, an assortment of judges, a State Attorney, a Sheriff and others. Although some people refer to this year as an "Off Year" election it is still critically important that you get out and VOTE. The future of your state depends on it!

Well, I've probably gone on too long, but there is still more to share. It will have to wait until next time. TANEYTOWN HISTORY MUSEUM 10 YEAR ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

The Taneytown History Museum celebrated the 10 year anniversary on August 2, 2014. There was a lot to celebrate since the museum opened 10 years ago. George B. Crouse and George Naylor were co-founders of the History Museum. The museum opened in August 2004 at 24 E. Baltimore Street and included displays of Civil War items on loan from many residents of Taneytown and the surrounding communities.

The museum is now located at 340 E. Baltimore Street and is in the midst of a capital fund raising campaign to raise funds to help with ADA accessible renovations and other improvements before the museum can open.

As the museum is currently closed, the anniversary celebration was held outside on the grounds of the museum and what a beautiful day it was. The event was very well attended and many volunteers dressed in period costume or dress or hat for the day.

Period costume cutouts for men and women were available for everyone to have their picture taken. There were period costumes available furnished by Sherrie Hahn. Free ice cream cones, cookies and drink were provided to all attendees.

A \$25 GIFT COULD SAVE A MOTHER'S LIFE

EVERY MOTHER HAS A BIRTH STORY.

In the United States, those stories usually involve a frantic trip to the hos-

pital where a team of nurses and doctors care for the new mom and her baby.

In some other countries, women have much different stories. Many of them don't have access to something as simple as clean and sterile supplies. Because of their less-than-sterile environments, infection is a common complication for women following child-birth. The World Health Organization estimates that infection causes 13 percent of child-birth-related deaths.

To date, IMA has provided more than 30,000 Safe Motherhood Kits for women in post-conflict areas, disaster zones and developing nations including Haiti, South Sudan, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Pakistan and others.

The IMA Safe Motherhood Kit is a package of clean and sterile birthing supplies, designed to help prevent infection. Each kit costs just \$25. They include sterile gloves, a sterile umbilical tie, a sterile scalpel, sterile gauze pads, plastic sheeting, an absorbent underpad, a bar of soap, washcloth, hat, tunic/gown and blanket.

These basic items can help save a woman's life and ensure a new baby gets to keep his or her mother. And it's easy to help.

ral death.

If they wish, participants may choose to hold one of our Prayer Life Chain signs: Signs stating "Jesus Heals and Forgives", "Pray to End Abortion", "Lord, Forgive us and our Nation", "Adoption, The Loving Option", "Abortion Hurts Women", "Abortion kills children", and "Life, The Natural Choice" (A Knights Of Columbus sign), are distributed beginning 15 minutes before the event, and whenever persons can arrive. Signs with telephone numbers of Pro Life pregnancy services and post-abortion healing counseling are also displayed. (NO graphic signs depicting abortion victims are permitted for display in the Prayer Life Chain event).
