## SAFEST PLACES TO LIVE

To find out what towns and cities rank as the safest communities in Maryland, Alarmsystemreviews.com analyzed data from different national sources, including the FBI's Uniform Crime Report. We limited our rankings to those cities and towns with a minimum population of 2,500 residents.

We calculated the overall crime rate for each place by looking at the total number of both violent and property crimes and the total reported population to determine the crime rate per 1,000 residents. We used this overall crime rate to rank each community and determine which places to live are the safest in the state of Maryland.

If a town or city was not included in the FBI Uniform Crime Report or has less than 2,500 residents, it was excluded from our rankings.

Taneytown was ranked #9 safest town in the state of Maryland. Founded in 1754 Taneytown became the seat of the Taneytown Hundred and was the first town in Maryland to make English the official language. The town is rich in historic landmarks and was designated as a Historic District with the National Register of Historic Places in 1978. Population: 6,743, Violent Crime Rates (per 1,000): 0.9, Property Crime Rates (per 1,000): 11.0

## WATER/SEWER BILLS

Water/Sewer bills were issued October 1st with a due date of October 31st. Any bill that has not been paid by the 31st will be assessed a 10% late penalty fee and will be due by November 18th by 3:00 PM. Water shut-off is scheduled after November 21st, 2016. If water service is interrupted for non-payment, there will be an additional restoration fee of \$50 to reconnect water service. Questions regarding your bill can be directed to the Water/Sewer Department at 410-751-1100. Payment arrangements are available to Homeowners ONLY and must be made prior to November 17th, 2016.

- Stop by in person at the City Office, at 17 E. Baltimore Street, open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Drop your payment in our drop box located on the front of our building on the right
- Mail your payment to our office, 17 E. Baltimore St.
- Pay online at [www.taneytown.org](http://www.taneytown.org) (A \$6.95 convenience fee is charged and collected by processor for every \$250)

### MONTHLY PRE-PAYMENT PLAN

Paying monthly on your water/sewer bill account continues to be an option for your household budget. Please be sure your account number is referenced at time of payment. All payments collected prior to the quarterly billing will be reflected on your account with the net balance due. Any over payments will remain on your account as a credit toward your next quarterly bill. If you want an annual average, please call the Water/Sewer Department at 410-751-1100.

### WATER AND SEWER RATES INCREASE

Effective with the quarterly billing period beginning July 1, 2016, water and sewer rates will increase. The new rates will be reflected on the bill for the quarter ending September 2016. Please keep in mind, that if final reads are requested after July 1, 2016, the new rates will apply. The new water rate will be \$7.63 per 1,000 gallons and the sewer rate will be at \$14.99 per 1,000 gallons. The rate increase is based on Ordinance No. 24-2016. Questions regarding the increase can be directed to the Water/Sewer Department at 410-751-1100.

### DEAR PROPERTY OWNERS:

The City of Taneytown would like to take this opportunity to clarify our policy on estimated water bills. If the City does not get a radio read of your water meter (we do not need to enter your property to get this reading), the system will estimate your bill based on the previous three (3) quarters usage. There will also be a message on the water bill stating METER CHECK DUE NOW - CALL ASAP. If you see this message, please contact the City office at 410-751-1100. We will set up an appointment with you to inspect our equipment and replace the battery that is located in your house.

If your bill has this note, please contact the City office at 410-751-1100, immediately, so that we can schedule a time to physically check the meter, obtain an actual read and/or complete needed repair, so we can obtain future radio reads. This process should take approximately 10 - 15 minutes. All you need to do is allow us a clear passage to your water meter in your home. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

### TRASH & RECYCLING:

- Week of Thanksgiving: No Change. Collection will take place on its regular scheduled pick-up day of Wednesday, November 23, 2016.
- Week of Christmas Day: No Change. Collection will take place on its regular scheduled pick-up day of Wednesday, December 28, 2016.
- Week of New Year's Day Holiday: No Change. Collection will take place on its regular scheduled pick-up day

of Wednesday, January 4, 2017.

Please set your trash and recycling out the night before the above scheduled collections.

Please be reminded trash collection is for household garbage only. The City's hauling company will not collect yard waste or building materials. Recycling containers containing trash will not be picked-up.

### LEAF PICK-UP

Curbside leaf pick-up will be provided once again this fall. This service will take place weekly on Tuesdays, from October 25, through December 6, 2016. Please pack the leaves in plastic bags only and place them at the curb by 7:30 a.m. No need to call and schedule for pick up. Bags should not weigh more than 30 pounds each, providing the bags are strong enough to support that weight when lifting. Please limit bag size to 50 gallon. Leaves will be taken to local farms and used as compost, thus allowing the use of plastic bags. Bags must be tied and contain LEAVES ONLY. No grass, tree branches, sod, or trash will be picked-up.

### GRASS CLIPPINGS

Clippings will be collected through Tuesday, December 6, 2016. You must call the City Office at 410-751-1100 no later than 3 p.m. Monday to schedule for pick up the next day. Paper kraft bags are still required for grass clipping disposal.

mentioned in the last issue that the City Council has been busy with legislation to insure only the highest levels of ethical standards are part of the fabric of our City government. The Council passed (4-1) Code of Conduct resolution that all elected officials are expected to abide by while in office. This was an omission that became evident when we realized that previously, we had no way to protect our citizens from elected officials that may act inappropriately. Linked to this is a Carter Resolution that was passed three months ago (4-1) allowing Council to remove a Councilperson from office, if guilty of wrong doing. This Charter Resolution was challenged, in the form of a Petition for Referendum by a few citizens in town, led by Robin Fraser and her husband Councilman Donald Fraser (who months before, Council censured for harassment of employees) under the premise that only the voters should be able to remove someone from office, guilty of wrongdoing or not. Some people have told me that they thought the referendum had to do with lowering water and sewer rates, but it has nothing to do with this. In order to bring a proposed Charter Resolution to referendum, twenty percent of the City's voters would have to sign the petition. We have received the petition. The required twenty percent has been reached. Consequently, at their September meeting, City Council set the date for a special election to resolve this challenge; the date has been set for November 15th. It is quite unusual for Taneytown to have such action challenged but it is very important that you mark the date on your calendars and I ask that all eligible citizens (registered voters) weigh in with their vote. The issue

is a simple one. Do you feel City Council should have the power to remove an elected official from office, who has been found guilty of wrong doing, or not. The actual wording of the ballot charter amendment will be discussed at a special Council meeting on October 5th, everyone is welcome to attend. Your vote for the Charter Amendment will insure that only people of integrity will serve you as elected officials.

In other news, you may have become aware that Robin Frazier, wife of Councilman Donald Frazier, has filed a law suit against the City of Taneytown for alleged violation of the state "Open Meeting" law. Your Mayor and City Council were served with these papers in a rather flamboyant fashion, at the September Council workshop by a process server. Because this is a legal issue I really can't go into much detail about the alleged violation, but assure you, I feel Council is in compliance with both the spirit and letter of the law. I refer you to an excellent editorial that appeared in the Carroll County Times on Sunday, September 11th for additional background

in this matter.

Enough of politics! As we look forward to Fall, it's time to get out and about. Our City has planned a lot of activities to help make the most of this season. On September 17th, we held the very popular Tails of Taneytown Pet Parade. During the past several years this event has been held in conjunction with Fall Fest. This year we decided to move it up and have it as a stand alone event. Registration began early 8:30 AM with judging at 10:30 AM and the location changed too. We held it behind the police station. So when the event was over, many had plenty of time to browse our downtown merchants. Those of you who haven't been downtown lately, make sure you stop by our newest business: Jumble, just across the street from the Country Kitchen. 





## City News

### TRASH COLLECTION CODE REMINDERS

Each Wednesday, the city provides curbside trash and recycling pick-up through a contract hauler, currently Hughes Trash Removal Inc. Many of us take out the trash and recycling Tuesday night & bring the empty cans back in sometime Wednesday. That's pretty much the way it's supposed to work, but there is actually a little more to it. City code provides very clear requirements about garbage, refuse, and rubbish - call it what you will - for this article I'll just say trash. Most of what follows is from the Health and Sanitation chapter (ch.124) of the City code.

Any premises in the city must have and keep covered an adequate number of metal, durable rubber, or durable plastic refuse containers with a capacity of 20 to 60 gallons. Larger containers are permitted if they can be handled mechanically. Containers that will not be handled mechanically and their contents must not exceed 60lbs. Not too complicated, right? Well, think for a moment about how many plastic bags you see on the curb each Wednesday, how many containers without lids are sitting there. Why worry about it? Well, the code also states that the containers shall be rodent and insect proof - a container without a lid, or a trash bag a few mils thick isn't going to do it. Many of us have noticed cats and dogs roaming (there's a subject for another article) quite interested in what's in those bags or containers without lids. Containers without lids also allow trash to be more easily scattered by the wind.

Containers may be placed in the appropriate location for collection up to 12 hours before the time of collection, and they must be removed from that spot to within, or to the rear of the premises until the next scheduled collection time. Again, not too tough, right? Ever notice containers or bags sitting out on the sidewalk on Thursday? Friday? Even until Monday? We sometimes see that residents whose homes are attached or in close proximity to others place their containers off to one side of their front yard, only to have them quite close to their neighbor's front walk or front door. Not something many of us would like to see or smell every time we come home.

Bulk items, essentially rubbish that doesn't fit in the trash can should be disposed of at the Carroll County Landfill, as the City does not provide for curbside bulk collection. An annual bulk trash day is offered at Memorial Park for residents to bring large items for disposal, but otherwise a trip to the landfill is in order for things like discarded furniture, large household items, tires, car seats etc. Items such as these are not to remain outdoors on properties and should be disposed of when they are no longer needed, and not simply jettisoned to the porch, under the deck, or to the yard, and certainly not to some nearby vacant property.


