

**CITY OF TANEYTOWN  
PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION  
RESOLUTION**

**ADOPTION OF CITY OF TANEYTOWN COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

PURSANT to the requirements of Section 3.05 of Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and applicable provisions of the Code of the City of Taneytown, the Taneytown Planning and Zoning Commission is required and empowered to adopt a Comprehensive Plan for recommendation to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Taneytown.

WHEREAS, pursuant to requirements of Section 3.07 of Article 66B of the Maryland Annotated Code, the Taneytown Planning and Zoning Commission approved the release of the Taneytown Comprehensive Plan for sixty day review on November 23, 2009; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3.05 of Article 66B of the Maryland Annotated Code, Notice of a Public Hearing was duly advertised on January 13, 2010; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the published Notice of Public Hearing, a public hearing was held on January 25, 2010, in which public comments were received; and

WHEREAS, the Taneytown Planning and Zoning Commission has determined to approved the Comprehensive Plan and recommend to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Taneytown for the adoption of the Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Taneytown Planning and Zoning Commission on a motion of Anchie and second by Glass, and carried by a vote of 5-0, representing the affirmative votes of not less than a majority of the membership, the Taneytown Planning and Zoning Commission hereby approves the Taneytown Comprehensive Plan, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy this Resolution and a report on the comments received and their recommendation thereon as required by Section 3.07 (d) of Article 66B of the Maryland Annotated Code, be transmitted to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Taneytown for appropriate action consistent with the laws of the State of Maryland.
